By making the investment and committing to become disability confident in early years recruitment organisations will not only ensure you are able to grow your talent pool, but it will also benefit your existing employees who have a disability or become disabled during their career. 83% of people acquire a disability as opposed to being born with it. The average age of acquiring a disability is 45.

Making it easy to engage with disabled students

Your organisation's profile on the Students' Club website provides you with an opportunity to market yourself as an employer of choice to disabled students. Guidance is provided by MyPlus to enable you to develop a profile which fully demonstrates your organisation's commitment to being inclusive of all potential applicants.

Outline your organisations' commitment to disability on your Company 'About Us' section

This is where you talk about how your organisation's commitment to disability has positively impacted the business and how your culture supports people with disabilities. You can introduce your disability networks, demonstrate any initiatives in place to help disabled students and employees succeed and showcase any employment, diversity and disability awards.

Profile your people

In this section you can provide insights into what it is like to work at your organisation as a Graduate or Experienced Hire/Professional who manages a disability by sharing their stories. Disabled students/graduates applying for roles are more comfortable being open about their own disability when they can see examples of others who have been open and were successful with their application.

• Detail your opportunities

Here you can provide an overview of your internship, graduate & apprenticeship opportunities & programmes. The Students' Club promotes these, for free, in our newsletters sent to our members, University Careers Services, student societies and faculties.

• Provide application advice

This section enables you to offer advice to disabled students who are thinking of applying to your organisation, such as key strengths/competencies you look for, tips on explaining mitigating circumstances or on being open. You can include videos from a senior manager, recruiter or recent graduate and links to your careers section on your company website.

Showcase disability support available

Inform potential candidates about the support and adjustments that are available during the recruitment process. Provide contact details for your disability expert, making it easy for disabled students to talk to you and discuss their requirements, helping to promote you as an approachable and disability confident employer. You can also highlight the support and adjustments available to employees once they have joined your organisation.

Advertise Events

Tell students about your upcoming careers events. These events will be featured in both your employer profile and the events section of the MyPlus Students' Club website and will be shared via our social media platforms.









